

## AGED, BLIND, AND DISABLED MEDICAID 201-7 Qualified Disabled Working Individuals (QDWI)

**Supersedes:** MA 201-10 (09/01/98)

Reference: ARM 46.12.3601 and .3603

**Overview:** An eligible Qualified Disabled Working Individual (QDWI) is a person:

- 1. who is entitled to re-enroll in Medicare Part A hospital insurance coverage because he/she lost premium-free Part A coverage due to engaging in a substantial gainful activity;
- 2. who meets all nonfinancial requirements which include:
  - a. being categorically eligible (i.e., disabled);
  - b. having or applying for a Social Security Number;
  - c. being a U. S. citizen or legally admitted alien; and
  - d. being a Montana resident;
- 3. whose income does not exceed 200% of the federal poverty guideline; and
- 4. <u>whose</u> resources do not exceed twice the Supplemental Security Income (SSI) general resource limit.

## **RETROACTIVE:**

Up to three months retroactive coverage is available to eligible QDWIs.

## **COVERAGE BENEFITS:**

A QDWI is only entitled to have monthly Medicare Part A (hospital insurance) premiums paid by Medicaid. Regular Medicaid benefits (e.g., prescriptions, physician visits, dental care, etc.) are not available to QDWIs.
