DPHHS 2023 Legislative Proposals

- State law and legislative rules require interim committees to review the legislation that state agencies plan to introduce during the next legislative session and allows the committees to authorize the early drafting and pre-introduction of such bills.
- DPHHS reports to the Children, Families, Health, and Human Services Interim Committee (CFHHS).
- The committee generally makes that review at its final meeting of the interim and DPHHS presented their legislative proposals to the CFHHS Interim Committee on August 26, 2022.
- The next legislative session begins January 2, 2023 and these concepts can now move through the entire legislative process.
