• **Overview:** In accordance with Governor Gianforte's HEART Initiative, awarded funding will support the implementation of a comprehensive behavioral health service continuum within local county and tribal detention facilities.

Menu of Services:

- Behavioral Health Therapy
- Certified Behavioral Health Peer Support
- Care Coordination
- Medication Prescription, Management, and Monitoring
- Medication for Opioid Use Disorder
- Funding: \$2.7 million over two years
 - Combination of HEART Revenue and Mental Health Block Grant
- Eligibility: Federally-recognized tribal government or county

- Q&A Period April 25th May 12th
- RFP closes on May 30th

• Grant Implementation Timeline:

- July 1, 2022 June 30, 2024 (2-year grant)
 - Future contract extensions and RFP will be facilitated in Spring of 2024
