

Montana's New Healthcare Plan

Montana has a new, low-cost healthcare option. You can sign up now for coverage that begins in January.

What is covered?

All the essentials are covered, including:

- Doctor, hospital, and emergency services
- Prescription drugs
- Dental care
- Vision care
- Laboratory and x-ray services
- Maternity and newborn care
- Mental health and substance abuse treatment
- Rehabilitative services and supplies
- Transportation to appointments

Who is eligible?

People earning below \$16,000 a year, or \$33,000 for a family of four who are:

- Montana residents
- Ages 19-64
- Not already in or able to get Medicare.

The Affordable Plan for Healthcare:

- No or low monthly premiums depending on your income.
- Small co-pays for doctor visits, with no co-pays for preventive services such as health screenings, help to quit smoking, or flu shots.
- No out-of-pocket above 5% of your total income.
