New Affordable Health Plan **AVAILABLE NOW**

New, low-cost healthcare is now available for most Montana residents. You can apply now for coverage that begins in January.

All the essentials are covered, including:

- Doctor, hospital, and emergency services
- Prescription drugs
- Dental care
- Vision care
- Laboratory and x-ray services
- Maternity and newborn care
- Mental health and substance abuse treatment
- Rehabilitative services and supplies
- Transportation to appointments

Who is eligible?

People earning below \$16,000 a year, or \$33,000 for a family of four who are:

- Montana residents
- Ages 19-64
- Not already in or able to get Medicare

The Affordable Choice for Healthcare

- Low or no monthly premiums depending on your income
- Small co-pays for doctor visits, with no co-pays for preventive services such as health screenings, help to quit smoking, or flu shots
- No out-of-pocket costs above 5% of your total income
