Proposed Severe Disabling Mental Illness (SDMI) Definition

SDMI is defined as an adult 18 years or older who presently or any time in the past 12 months has had a diagnosable mental illness that has interfered with functioning and has resulted in significant difficulty in community living without supportive treatment or services of a long-term or indefinite duration. These individuals struggle daily with severe mental illness that is chronic and persistent resulting in impaired functioning.

- SDMI eligible if the adult has been involuntarily hospitalized for at least 30 consecutive days because of a mental disorder at Montana State Hospital within the past 12 months.*
- Has a diagnosis within the Schizophrenia Spectrum Disorder category. (F20.0, F20.1, F20.2, F20.5, F22, F25.0, or F25.1)*
- If not, complete sections 1 and 2 below.*

CRITERIA (must meet at least one in each category)

1. Eligible Diagnosis

Excluding mild, not otherwise specified (NOS), unspecified; physiological disturbances; or physical factors.

2. SDMI Level of Impaired Functioning Areas

Level of Impairment (LOI) Score (*from LOI Worksheet*): _____

Level A

- 3 or more areas with a total score of 6 or above; or
- 4 or more areas with a total score of 8 or above

Level B

- 3 or more areas with a total score of 9 and above; or
- 4 or more areas with a total score of 12 and above

ELIGIBILITY DETERMINATION FORMULA

To determine SDMI eligibility, diagnosis category must meet the following level of impairment:

1. Category I **and** Impaired Level of Functioning A **or** B.
2. Category II **and** Impaired Level of Functioning B.
