Description

The State of Montana is developing services for individuals, age birth to age 21, with a diagnosis of autism spectrum disorder (ASD) or related condition. Services will be funded through Medicaid State Plan dollars. Members must be enrolled in Montana Medicaid and meet identified medical necessity criteria to be eligible for treatment. Treatment plan, implementation guidance, and intensive treatment are the 3 types of services available under this plan. This new plan will be overseen by the Developmental Disabilities Program within the Department of Public Health and Human Services.
