Overview:	<p>Children eligible for IV-E or non-IV-E adoption subsidies are automatically eligible for Subsidized Adoption Medicaid.</p> <p>NOTE: Subsidized adoption cases are not used for any program other than subsidized adoption. If the family applies for other coverage, a new case may need to be opened if one doesn't already exist.</p>
PROCESSING	Policy Bureau in HCSD central office maintains the subsidized adoption caseload.
