Overview:	<p>Parents or Caretaker Relatives may qualify for ACA Parent/Caretaker Relative (PCR) Medicaid if they have an eligible child living in their home. An eligible child is a child under age 19 who is within the 5th degree of kinship of the caretaker relative, including children receiving SSI.</p> <p>NOTE: If the child's parent is in the home, a caretaker relative cannot receive ACA PCR coverage.</p> <p>Total countable income is tested against the ACA PCR income standard (FMA 003).</p>
NONFINANCIAL CRITERIA	<p>Medicaid standard nonfinancial requirements are listed in section CMA 300. In addition to the standard criteria that applies to all Medicaid programs, the following nonfinancial criteria are specific to ACA PCR:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Child must be living with a parent/specified caretaker relative• Age (must be a dependent child under age 19 within 5th degree of kinship)
