<b>Overview:</b>	<p>GENERAL RULE--Certain disabled adult children (DAC) may qualify for categorically needy Medicaid (i.e., no spend down).</p> <p>DAC coverage is limited to individuals who:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Meet all non-financial eligibility criteria;</li><li>2. Are within resource limitations;</li><li>3. Lost SSI/SSP eligibility after July 1, 1987, due to entitlement to or an increase in Social Security DAC benefits.</li></ol> <p><b>NOTE:</b> An increase to a DAC benefit could include COLA.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>4. Currently receive Social Security DAC Benefits; and</li><li>5. Do not reside in a residential medical facility.</li></ol> <p>All criteria listed above (1-5) must be met to correctly determine DAC Medicaid Eligibility. Simply verifying current receipt of Social Security DAC benefits is not sufficient.</p>
<b>DAC &amp; WAIVER</b>	<p>DAC Medicaid clients may also receive services under a Medicaid waiver</p> <p>For couples, both spouses must be covered under the same waiver program.</p>
<b>EFFECTIVE DATE</b>	July 1, 2016
