



# COMBINED MEDICAID 305-1 NONFINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS - Age

<b>Overview:</b>	<p>Certain coverage groups have age-related limits to be eligible to receive Medicaid coverage.</p> <p><b>ACA and Family Medically Needy:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Children may be eligible through the month of their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday;</li><li>• Parents/Specified Caretaker relatives and pregnant women of any age may be eligible;</li><li>• Adults age 19 through 64 may be eligible for ACA Adult or ACA Adult Medicaid coverage</li><li>• Newborn children, eligible under the Child Newborn program, may be eligible through the month of their first birthday</li></ul> <p><b>ABD:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Disabled children may be eligible through the month of their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday;</li><li>• Disabled adults may be eligible through age 64</li><li>• Adults, age 65 or older are considered 'aged'</li><li>• PRTF eligibility is limited to individuals age six through 17</li><li>• MWD eligibility is limited to individuals age 16 and older</li><li>• Autism waiver is limited to children age 15 months up to 8 years old</li></ul>
