



## SNAP 104-4 Re-Application/Revert to Open

<b>References:</b>	7 CFR 273.10, 7 CFR 273.2
<b>Overview:</b>	<u>GENERAL RULE</u> -- When an individual reapplies for SNAP benefits after a break in participation of <u>any length of time</u> , benefits are prorated from the date of the re-application. The exception is: migrant and seasonal farm worker households who receive a full month's benefits if they reapply after a break in participation of less than 30 days.
