



# 300 Non-Financial Eligibility Requirements Overview

<b>Overview:</b>	<p>GENERAL RULE—After it is determined which family members comprise the filing unit; the eligibility determination occurs to establish which of these members, in addition to the minor child, will have their needs included in the benefits. The eligibility determination is made by considering all nonfinancial criteria and all financial criteria of each filing unit member. Those members meeting the criteria will have their needs included in benefits and are collectively referred to as the assistance unit. There must be an eligible minor child in the assistance unit for other related family members to be eligible.</p> <p>The nonfinancial requirements which must be met by each filing unit member in relation to the determination of need are:</p> <table border="0"> <thead> <tr> <th style="text-align: left;">REQUIREMENT</th> <th style="text-align: left;">MANUAL SECTION</th> </tr> </thead> <tbody> <tr> <td>1. The 60 month time-clock has not been exhausted. 801-1</p> <p>NOTE: If the 60-month time clock has been exhausted, all adult household members must meet an extension criterion to be eligible for extended TANF cash assistance. (TANF 801-3)</p>
<b>VERIFICATION OF CRITERIA</b>	It is not necessary to verify all nonfinancial criteria.
