

HEPATITIS C (HCV)

75% of Hepatitis C+ people are Baby Boomers (DOB 1945-1965)

HCV related deaths in the US have surpassed those from 60 other infectious diseases, including HIV, Pneumococcal illness, and TB


3.5 million in the US are estimated to be infected with HCV, half are unaware

Treatment can eliminate the Hepatitis C virus


2015 - 1,272 cases of chronic Hepatitis C reported in Montana

Hepatitis C is the second most commonly reported illness in Montana

8 out of 10 infected individuals will develop chronic hepatitis

75% of people with Hepatitis are Baby Boomers




Hepatitis C can cause liver damage and liver failure
