

MEASURING PROGRESS -- Montana 2016 HIV Prevention & Treatment Goals

Prevention Goal #1
Reduce the number of Montanans who become infected




Measure: Decrease infection Rate of 2.4/100,000 by 2016

Prevention Goal #2
Decrease risky behavior

Waiting for data from Client Survey


Measure: 5% fewer persons report having unprotected sex

Prevention Goal #3
Increase proportion of people living with HIV who know they are infected




Measure: Through targeted testing, increase contractors' sero-positivity rate by .1% annually (2014, 4 HIV+/1876 tests. 2015, 9 HIV+/2157)

Prevention Goal #4
Increase proportion of HIV+ who are linked to prevention & care



Measure: By 2016, estimated number of people infected with HIV, not receiving medical care will decrease to 10%

Treatment Goal #1
Increase proportion of Ryan White* clients with undetectable viral loads



Measure: 95% will have undetectable viral loads by 2016

Measure: Increase housing from 80% to 90% by 2016

Treatment Goal #2
Increase proportion of Ryan White clients who are permanently housed

*Ryan White is a federal assistance program that pays for treatment for the underinsured
