Outbreak of *Botulism* Associated with Canned Chili

Many of you have been actively involved in checking with your local retailers and food banks to assure that these products have been removed from store shelves. Thanks for your diligence. FDA, USDA and FCSS have also been auditing retailers and reporting their findings. If you have been visiting or contacting retailers in your jurisdictions and have not submitted an audit form or other type of report to FCSS, please do so as soon as possible. If the audit form is not used, provide at least the name and city location of the establishment contacted/visited, and whether the retailer had any of the recalled products on display or in storage.

Attached are the most recent documents associated with this nationwide recall of canned human and pet food products. Media coverage of this recall has been spotty in MT so in an effort to increase exposure to the consumer level, a Public Service Announcement has been developed to air on radio stations across the state (script attached), and information has been added to the state DPHHS web page at www.health.mt.gov for easy access (big square button titled HEALTH ALERT). Also attached is a spread sheet listing the firms visited to date by FDA and FCSS and the latest releases from FDA.

Consumers are being encouraged to notify the store manager and contact the state or their local health department if they discover recalled products on store shelves.

Background

CDC has notified state health officials of an investigation of an outbreak of botulism associated with canned hot dog chili sauce. As of July 21, 2007, four cases of botulism have been reported to CDC from Indiana (2 cases) and Texas (2 cases). Onset dates range from June 29 to July 9, 2007. All four persons were reported to have consumed Castleberry's brand Hot Dog Chili Sauce Original. Botulinum toxin was identified in leftover chili sauce from an unlabeled sealable bag collected from a patient's refrigerator.

Due to possible contamination with botulinum toxin, CDC, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), and the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Food Safety and Inspection Service (USDA-FSIS) are advising persons not to eat certain canned food products manufactured by Castleberry's Food Company. These include certain Castleberry's brands as well as products distributed under other brand names. The recall includes some canned dog food. Persons with signs or symptoms of botulism who have eaten Castleberry's brand Hot Dog Chili Sauce or any of the other recalled products are advised to immediately contact their health care provider. These include new onset of double vision, blurred vision, drooping eyelids, slurred speech, difficulty swallowing, or muscle weakness. If untreated, the illness may progress from head to toe, with paralysis of the face, arms, breathing muscles, trunk, and legs. Symptoms generally begin 18 to 36 hours after eating a contaminated food, but they can occur as early as 6 hours or as late as 10 days. Health care providers evaluating persons with signs of botulism should contact their State health department immediately.

This is an update on recent activity and press releases issued since July 25, 2007 in regards to the outbreak of botulism related to Castleberry's product and the subsequent recall. Activities you may find of interest are:

- In an update posted today (7/27/07) (see <<http://www.fda.gov/oc/opacom/hottopics/castleberry/update072707.html> >) it is reported that FDA investigators are finding potentially contaminated product still being sold in 307 out of the 3,788 stores they visited. In most cases the products were found in smaller stores, independent grocers, and convenience stores. When found, the recalled products were removed and secured. Consumers are being asked to bring any recalled product found on the shelf of their local store to the store manager's attention.

Given the potentially fatal effects of botulism poisoning and the fact that over 90 products and 27 brands of food are potentially contaminated, consumers need to carefully check their pantries and cupboards and dispose of any recalled product immediately. These canned chili products, stew, hash, BBQ, gravy, and pet food all could cause life-threatening illness.

We are trying to share the below information regarding the Castleberry recall with as many salvager and food bank organizations as possible. We need your help to spread the word. There is no national salvage operation for FDA to contact and it is important that the state officials share the information provided below with their local health and ag departments so that they can follow-up on salvage operations and those operations supplying food to the needy within their jurisdiction's authority. The attachment below is a message for retailers and food service establishments regarding the removal and disposal of recalled products due to botulism hazard.

Background

A nationwide recall of certain canned human food and dog food products manufactured by Castleberry Food Company of Augusta, Georgia was announced on July 18, 2007 and expanded on July 21, 2007. As a result, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) are warning consumers not to open or eat canned products identified as part of the recall or to feed any of the canned products to their pets. These products may contain hazardous botulinum toxin. Botulism can be fatal. Human illnesses have been associated with two of the recalled human food products.

FDA and USDA are currently asking retailers and foodservice operations to respond immediately to remove and secure recalled products, making sure that all recalled products are not inadvertently made available for purchase, salvage or donation and

therefore preventing any possibility for human or animal consumption. Castleberry Food Company has established a plan for recalling its affected products. Retailers should follow the instructions received from the company or its distribution centers for removing, marking and securing the products. Further suggestions for the proper removal of recalled products from further circulation and disposal of recalled products are provided below.

Removal of Recalled Products from Circulation

All recalled products should be removed from store shelves and separated from other stock immediately. If possible, use additional safeguards, such as locking out the UPC codes at check-out, to ensure these products are not sold to consumers and cashiers informed of the hazard and cautioned not to override the lockout.

Removed recalled products should be kept in a secure area and identified with signs that have bold, clear lettering indicating that the products pose an extreme health hazard. Removed recalled products need to be clearly marked to prevent restocking, re-entry into commerce (including donation to food or pet food banks), or diversion to food or pet food salvage operations. Consider shrink wrapping recalled products to ensure they do not accidentally find their way back into commerce.

Disposal of Recalled Products

Recalled products should be isolated from other stock, secured and tagged for pick-up or disposal as directed by Castleberry or their designee. Disposal must be done in accordance with State and local regulations and ordinances and in a manner that will prevent diversion of the recalled products. Recalled products should not be disposed of by placing them in unsecured garbage cans, dumpsters or other receptacles in a manner that could result in subsequent removal by individuals for their own use or for sale to others.

Particular care should be used when handling and disposing of cans that show signs of swelling or leakage to prevent any human exposure to the contents of the cans.

Special Precautions for Handling and Disposing of Opened Cans of Recalled Products

Opened containers of the recalled products or any foods made with the recalled products should be discarded with extreme care. An open container of a food included in this recall should be disposed of as follows: 1) place the open container in a sealable plastic bag 2) place the sealed plastic bag containing the open product inside two additional plastic bags and then tightly tape the bags closed and 3) place the sealed/taped plastic bags containing the opened product in a secure trash receptacle for non-recyclable trash. Do not discard any of the recalled food in a sink, garbage disposal or toilet.

Wear rubber gloves when handling open containers of suspect food. Wash hands thoroughly after handling suspect food or containers. Take care to avoid splashing or inhaling food when discarding it. Avoid contact with the skin or eyes. Sponges, cloths, rags and gloves that may have come into contact with contaminated food or containers should be discarded with the food.

Informing Employees and Consumers of Recall

Employees should be informed of the hazard associated with the recalled products. Signs should be posted on removed recalled products to inform employees on all shifts that the product is hazardous and being held for disposal.

Store employees should alert consumers to the recall and the serious health hazard associated with exposure to the toxin. Consider posting signs on shelves and elsewhere in the store, and using other means of shopper notification to warn consumers not to open, taste or eat the recalled products. Inform consumers that any recalled products in their homes should be discarded carefully. More information for consumers is available at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention website at

Recall Audit Checks

Distribution centers and retail food stores may be visited by Federal, state or local officials conducting checks to determine the extent to which recalled product is being taken out of circulation. These officials will ask questions about the recall notification received, actions taken as a result of the notification, and status of recalled product in your establishment.

Please note: The UPC codes for a few of the products originally posted on the Castleberry, FDA and USDA websites and in the retail outreach message that was sent out earlier in .pdf form did not match up to the products identified. The UPC codes for all recalled products listed on the website should now be accurate. It appears that some of the previously listed UPC codes reflected case or lot codes rather than product codes.

The website mentioned above lists all the products in the recall and is updated as needed. The state and local inspectors could print out a hard copy of these products and use it as a tool to share this issue with the all retailers they inspect also. This way if they should happen to run across one of the recalled products on the shelves during their inspections, they could bring it to the management's attention.
