

5.2 Condoms

SUBJECTIVE	<u>Must Include:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. LMP.2. Medical history update.3. Negative history of allergy to rubber.4. If used jointly with vaginal spermicide, negative history of allergy to foam/jelly.
OBJECTIVE	Recommended but not required: Routine physical exam with other systems as indicated.
LABORATORY	Routine laboratory.
ASSESSMENT	Annual exam (Initial exam).
PLAN	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Instruction in use of condoms.2. RTC every year for annual exam or p.r.n. for problems or questions regarding methods.
PATIENT EDUCATION	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Reinforce vaginal spermicide education (high effectiveness when used in conjunction with condoms).2. Counsel regarding deterioration of condoms with use of intravaginal medications and petroleum based lubricants.3. Educate regarding condom effectiveness for STI/HIV prevention.
