

5.5 Cervical Cap – 3 month check

SUBJECTIVE	<u>Must Include:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. LNMP and PMP.2. History of problems: For example,<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Uncomfortable when cervical cap in place.
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OBJECTIVE	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Pelvic exam.2. Visualization of cervix.
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LABORATORY	Repeat Pap smear.
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ASSESSMENT	Cervical cap check.
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PLAN	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Check cervical cap for correct fit and usage.2. RTC for follow-up exam or p.r.n. for problems with cervical cap.
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PATIENT EDUCATION	Reinforce cervical cap education. *If patient has had Hx of abnormal Pap with treatment, and follow-up of tx with normal Pap smear, there is insufficient data to conclude that the use of the cervical cap will not contribute to a recurrence of an abnormal Pap smear.
