

5.2 PAP TEST REPORT

Policy: The Pap Test Report provides information on the cervical screening activities that are performed in Title X clinics. The report includes the number of Pap tests performed (not persons referred) with atypical squamous cells (ASC) or higher result, and the number of Pap test with high-grade squamous intraepithelial lesions (HSIL) or higher, result for Title X clients in a calendar year (January – December).

Procedure:

1. All Title X clinics must complete and submit to the Pap Test Report to WMHS by January 20th of each year. It is the responsibility of sub-recipient clinics to ensure that the data is submitted for all of their satellites by the due date.
2. The number of Pap tests should include conventional and thin prep Pap tests. This does not include results of benign cellular changes, inflammation or reactive reparative results.
