Subject: Medicaid Eligibility Requirements

Medicaid ELIGIBILITY: Applicants for Medicaid must meet eligibility criteria for the appropriate assistance program. All persons applying for Medicaid must meet an income and resource test. The eligibility staff in the County Office of Public Assistance is responsible for determining initial and ongoing financial eligibility for Medicaid. Refer all Medicaid eligibility questions to the appropriate County Office of Public Assistance.

Each month the provider agency must verify continued Medicaid eligibility for each member. The following sources may be accessed to determine eligibility:
