

Confirm Eligibility

MFP

Confirming a participant's eligibility will be an ongoing process. Transition work can begin prior to meeting eligibility requirements if it looks like the person will be a likely candidate for the Money Follows the Person program.

To qualify for the Money Follows the Person program, the following requirements must be met:

- 90 consecutive days in an inpatient facility
- Must be Medicaid eligible for at least one day prior to transition
- Qualify and enroll in one of the following HCBS waivers or State Plan programs according to each program's requirements:
 - Big Sky Waiver (elderly or physically disabled) – SLTC
 - Severe Disabling Mental Illness Waiver (SDMI) – AMDD
 - 0208 Comprehensive Waiver – DSD
 - 1915(i) State Plan services for youth with serious emotional disturbance (SED)

The State Transition Coordinator and/or Regional Transition Coordinator will work with the local Offices of Public Assistance, Mountain Pacific Quality Health, waiver case management teams, regional managers, and wraparound facilitators as appropriate to assist the participant in meeting eligibility requirements.

During this process step, a Regional Transition Coordinator (RTC) will be identified. See the "Demonstration Services" section for a detailed description of the Regional Transition Coordinator role.

The RTC role will be formalized with a written letter of approval identifying the RTC and the MFP participant. The date on the approval letter will begin the RTC role with MFP. For those able to bill for this Demonstration Service, this marks the beginning of this service. More will be covered regarding billing in the "Provider Billing" section.

To accept the RTC role, sign and date the "Regional Transition Coordinator Acceptance Form" and return it to the State Transition Coordinator.
