A referral has been made to the Money Follows the Person program. In order to be considered for the Money Follows the Person program, a person must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- 90 consecutive days living in an in-patient facility;
- Medicaid eligible for at least one day prior to transition
- Qualify and enroll in one of the following Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) waivers:
  - Big Sky Waiver (elderly or physically disabled)
  - Severe Disabling Mental Illness Waiver (SDMI)
  - 0208 Comprehensive Waiver
  - 1915(i) State Plan services for youth with serious emotional disturbance (SED)

Further, housing must meet specific criteria to be considered as a residential setting in the community.

At this time, participation in the Money Follows the Person program is denied due to eligibility requirements are not met.
