

ACA/FAMILY MEDICAID 007 Table of Standards: ACA Adult/ACA Adult Income

Supersedes: FMA 007 (04/01/2022)

Reference: ARM 37.82.101, .301; ARM 37.84.101-.115; 42 CFR 435.119; SB 405 (MCA 17-7-502 and 27-

2-205)

Overview: Individuals and parents/caretaker relatives ages 19-64 may qualify for health coverage if:

1. They meet the nonfinancial criteria for ACA Adult/ACA Adult Medicaid and;

2. Household income does not exceed 133 percent of the federal poverty level.

COMPUTATION:

The following standards are effective April 1, 2023.
