Montana is pleased to accept the Section 1115 Montana Health and Economic Livelihood Partnership (HELP) Demonstration (Project Number 11-W-00300/8) Waiver Special Terms and Conditions as presented in the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) letter dated December 20, 2017.

Through this demonstration and associated state plan amendments the state will no longer contract with a third party administrator (TPA) to deliver Medicaid Expansion to eligible residents. Montana will also amend the copay structure to remove the premium credit.
