STATE PLAN MANDATORY SERVICES

Medicaid services required by the federal government include:

- X Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis and Treatment (EPSDT) for individuals under age 21. In addition to all available State Plan Medicaid services, children may also receive these services: chemical dependency treatment, chiropractic, dietitian, residential treatment facilities, private duty nursing, respiratory therapy, school-based services, therapeutic group and foster care.
- X Family Planning
- X Home Health (For individuals age 21 and over, supplies, nursing services, and aide services only.)
- X Inpatient Hospital
- X Laboratory and X-ray
- X Medical and surgical services of a dentist
- X Nurse Midwife
- X Nurse Practitioner
- X Nursing Facility Care
- X Outpatient Hospital
- X Physician
- X Rural Health Clinics (including Federally Qualified Health Centers)
- X Transportation

STATE PLAN OPTIONAL SERVICES
