DEFINITION

A personal emergency response system (PERS) is an electronic device or mechanical system used to summon assistance in an emergency situation. The system alerts medical professionals, support staff or other designated persons to respond to an individual's emergency request.

SERVICE REQUIREMENT

A personal emergency response system must be connected to a local emergency response unit with the capacity to activate emergency medical personnel.
