Nonmedical Transportation**

**DEFINITION**

Nonmedical transportation is the provision of transportation to an individual through common carrier or private vehicle for access to social or other nonmedical activities.

**SERVICE REQUIREMENTS**

Transportation services must meet the following criteria:

1. Be provided only after volunteer transportation services, or transportation services funded by other programs have been exhausted; and
2. Be provided by the most cost effective mode.

Transportation providers must provide proof of:

1. A valid Montana driver's license;
2. Adequate automobile insurance;
3. Assurance that the vehicle is in compliance with applicable federal, state, local laws and regulations.
