



MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES PROGRAM

WHAT IS IT?

This program is set up to pay for mental health services while the member is in a detention center setting and is not enrolled in Medicaid. Medicaid will not pay for services while in a detention center. It does not pay for services if the person is serving a criminal sentence. Those services would be covered by Department of Corrections. Once a person is out of the detention center their MHSP will be closed. A person should seek to be enrolled in a Medicaid program when discharged from a detention center.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Services will be paid thru the claims system at Conduent. Providers bill fee for service. No contracts are required. This program pays for mental health services only. Physical health services are not covered. It also pays up to \$425 for pharmacy services per month.

HOW CAN I GET INVOLVED?

Contact your local mental health service provider.

WHO SUBMITS THE APPLICATION?

Applications are submitted to the Addictive and Mental Disorders Division. The Medicaid Enrollment Application and clinical intake form are required to enroll in MHSP.

AVAILABLE FUNDS:

\$150,000 dollars is available for FY18.
