

## Healthy Montana Kids (CHIP)

### State Plan Changes Implement July 1, 2015

#### State Plan Amendment Revisions:

- remove the three-month waiting period for enrollment of insured children;
- comply with federal provider credentialing rules;
- allow per diem and transportation for one adult companion for a child receiving medically necessary out-of-town or out-of-state medical services;
- clarify that organ and tissue procurement and transplant related medical services for living donors are part of the transplant benefit;
- clarify that weight gain drugs are covered when medically necessary;
- increase the limit on therapeutic family care from 30 to 90 days per benefit year;
- institute 14 days per benefit year reimbursement limit for therapeutic group home therapeutic home leave;
- allow over-the-counter steroid nasal sprays and benzoyl peroxide; and
- change the state plan reference to the Drug Use Education (DUE) Concurrent and Retrospective Evaluation (CARE) Board to reflect the current title of Drug Utilization Review (DUR) Board; and
- eliminate reimbursement for services provided by naturopathic physicians (effective October 1, 2015).
