

8 DAY LETTER

Under the authority of MCA 40-5-412 an 8 Day Letter may be issued if a support order is not subject to immediate income withholding and all or a portion of the child support payment is 8 days past due for any month in which child support was owed. If the parent owing support does not pay the delinquent amount within 8 working days delinquency income withholding for current support will be immediately initiated. If the delinquency is paid in full within 8 working days delinquency income withholding will not be initiated, but the case will be monitored monthly to insure that payments remain current. If at any time after issuance of the 8 Day Letter, all or a portion of the child support payment is delinquent, immediate income withholding may be initiated without further notification to the parent who owes support.
