

About Child Support Services

Child support services are provided to either parent, or to a third-party with whom the child(ren) resides by court order or with the consent of the parent who has legal custody.

We can help with:

- Locate services
- Parentage establishment
- Establishment of support and medical orders
- Enforcement of support and medical orders
- Order review and modification

We cannot help with:

- Custody and visitation establishment, modification or enforcement
- Collection of interest or payment on medical bills unless reduced to judgment
- Collection of attorney's fees
- Collection of spousal support when no child support is owed
- Enforcement of property settlements

Interstate Cases: The Child Support Services Division (CSSD) may request assistance from a child support agency in another state to work your case. If it is referred to another state that state controls the action taken in the case.
