Length of Meal Service

The State agency follows licensing regulations 37.95.215 Nutrition (2)(b) in regards to length of meal service.

This regulations states: (2) *“Each day care center must do the following, (b) Serve meals and snacks on, at a minimum, the following schedule to children in attendance:*

(i) Snacks at mid-morning and mid-afternoon;

(ii) Lunch; and

(iii) Breakfast, before 9:00 am, or supper if a child is being cared for in the center at the normal time for those meals and has not otherwise received them.
