Overview:	Medicaid clients who want to avail themselves of child support services can complete a child support referral. There is no penalty when a client chooses not to cooperate.
ASSIGNMENT OF RIGHTS	<p>Assignment of rights to medical support is automatic when the client signs the 'Application for Assistance', the Streamlined Health Coverage application and the online application.</p> <p>The assignment begins when Medicaid is approved and ends when Medicaid is closed.</p>
REFERRAL FORM (HCS/CS-332)	<p>Clients who want to receive child support services complete the HCS/CS-332 'Child Support Enforcement Referral' with information regarding the non-custodial parent.</p> <p>Clients receiving coverage under any of the following programs can choose to complete a Child Support Referral:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. ACA Parent/Caretaker Relative;2. Qualified Pregnant Woman; and3. Family Medically Needy.
