Supersedes: **New to HMK Manual**

General Rule – Healthy Montana Kids (HMK) applicants must provide evidence of identity prior to receiving HMK benefits.

NOTE: HMK will use SVES to verify identify whenever possible.

EVIDENCE OF IDENTITY

Identity can be established for:

1. Children less than 16 years of age by a signed affirmation included on a new or renewal HMK application form; or
2. Youth age 16 through 18 by:
 - a. a drivers' license with a photograph or other identifying information (i.e., name, age, gender, race, height, weight and eye color);

NOTE: Do not accept a Canadian driver's license.

- b. a school ID with a photograph;
- c. a U.S. military card;
- d. a federal, state or local government ID card which includes the same information as a drivers' license;
- e. a military dependent's ID card;
- f. a Native American Tribal document;
- g. a U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner card; or
- h. a Certificate of Degree of Indian Blood or other U.S. American Indian/Alaskan Native tribal document so long as it includes a photograph of the youth or has other identifying information (i.e., name, age, gender, race, height, weight and eye color).

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
