**General Rule** -- There are no maximum annual or lifetime limits on medically necessary benefits.

**NOTE:** There are no pre-existing condition limitations for a child enrolled in HMK, which means benefits for covered services are available the date a child is enrolled.

**IDENTIFICATION  
CARD**

A HMK-enrolled child's identification (ID) card is mailed by BCBSMT. The family generally receives the ID card about the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the first enrollment month. The ID card includes the child's ID number, name, birth date and whether the family is responsible for co-payments when medical services are received.

An updated ID card will be mailed to a child whose family has paid the \$215 maximum yearly co-payment.

**EXAMPLE:** The Brandt Family includes five children. Their family span is April 1 through March 31. On November 19, BCBSMT notes the family has paid \$215 in co-payments. A new ID card is printed for each child indicating medical providers do not have to collect a co-payment for services.

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
