Overview:	GENERAL RULE: SNAP participants are issued a debit card for purchasing food products. The SNAP benefits are electronically transferred to an account linked to the debit card. Participants will use the card, along with a Personal Identification Number (PIN) to purchase food, using a Point-of-Sale (POS) device, or the paper voucher system at the check stand. There is no charge when using the EBT card. This section addresses program benefits or EBT, the negotiable instrument, participants will use to purchase USDA eligible food items. Occasionally, benefits must be replaced to participant households. This information explains conditions when benefits may be replaced via the EBT Montana Access Card. The SNAP 901-1 and SNAP 902-1 sections include reference information to assist CSC with completing post benefit authorization activities.
