The Department of Public Health and Human Services has been unable to conduct our usual tribal tours due to the COVID-19 pandemic. We value the in-person visits and very much look forward to the time when we can again be in your tribal chambers.

Since we are unable to deliver the reports in person, we have decided that mailing the most recent Medicaid Revenue Report would be beneficial so you continue to get the information. The attached report outlines Medicaid reimbursement payments made for the period covering:

- Full State Fiscal Year 2019 – July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019
- Partial State Fiscal Year 2020 – July 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019

The reimbursement reflected is based on date of payment (the date the bill was paid) rather than date of service (the date the person received care).

Depending on how you track Medicaid reimbursement internally, your revenue received accounts may vary from what our reports show, this may be because they are for a slightly different time period, as the state fiscal year runs from July 1 to June 30.
