

PROPERTY AND KINSHIP GUIDELINES

ENROLLED PROVIDERS.

An enrolled provider or marijuana-infused products provider (MIPP) may not share with, rent or lease to another enrolled provider, another enrolled MIPP or a registered cardholder any portion of the property used for cultivation and manufacture of marijuana.

REGISTERED CARDHOLDERS.

Registered Cardholders and Enrolled Providers and Marijuana-infused products providers (MIPP).

A registered cardholder may not share with, rent or lease to an enrolled provider or MIPP any portion of the property used for cultivation and manufacture of marijuana for his or her use.

Registered Cardholders and Other Registered Cardholders.

A registered cardholder may not share or own with, rent or lease to another registered cardholder any portion of the property used for cultivation and manufacture of marijuana for his or her use unless:

- the registered cardholders are related as mother, father, brother, sister, son, daughter, spouse, grandparent, grandchild, mother-in-law, father-in-law, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, grandparent-in-law, grandchild-in-law, stepfather, stepmother, stepbrother, stepsister, stepson, stepdaughter, stepgrandparent, or stepgrandchild; and
- the other cardholder is not an enrolled provider or Marijuana-infused products provider.
