Here are 5 EASY ways to **GET TESTED**:

## at home

There are two FDA approved home HIV testing kits currently available. Both can be purchased at most large pharmacies.

## at school

Many colleges and universities have health clinics on campus that offer HIV and STD testing all year. Check with your school to find out where and how you can be tested.

## at your health department or provider's office
