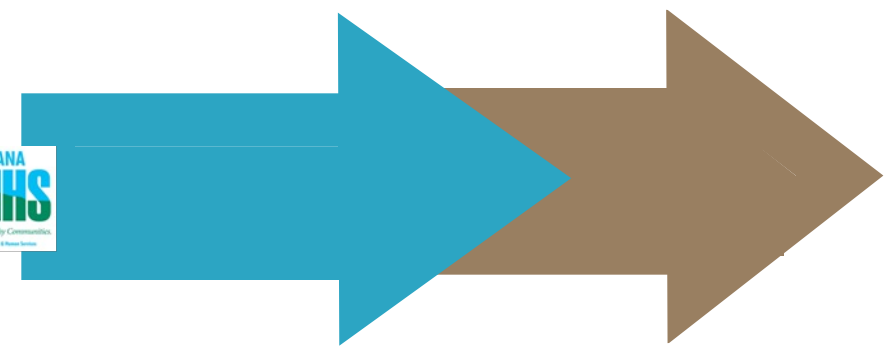


National Immunization Survey (NIS) 2009-2016

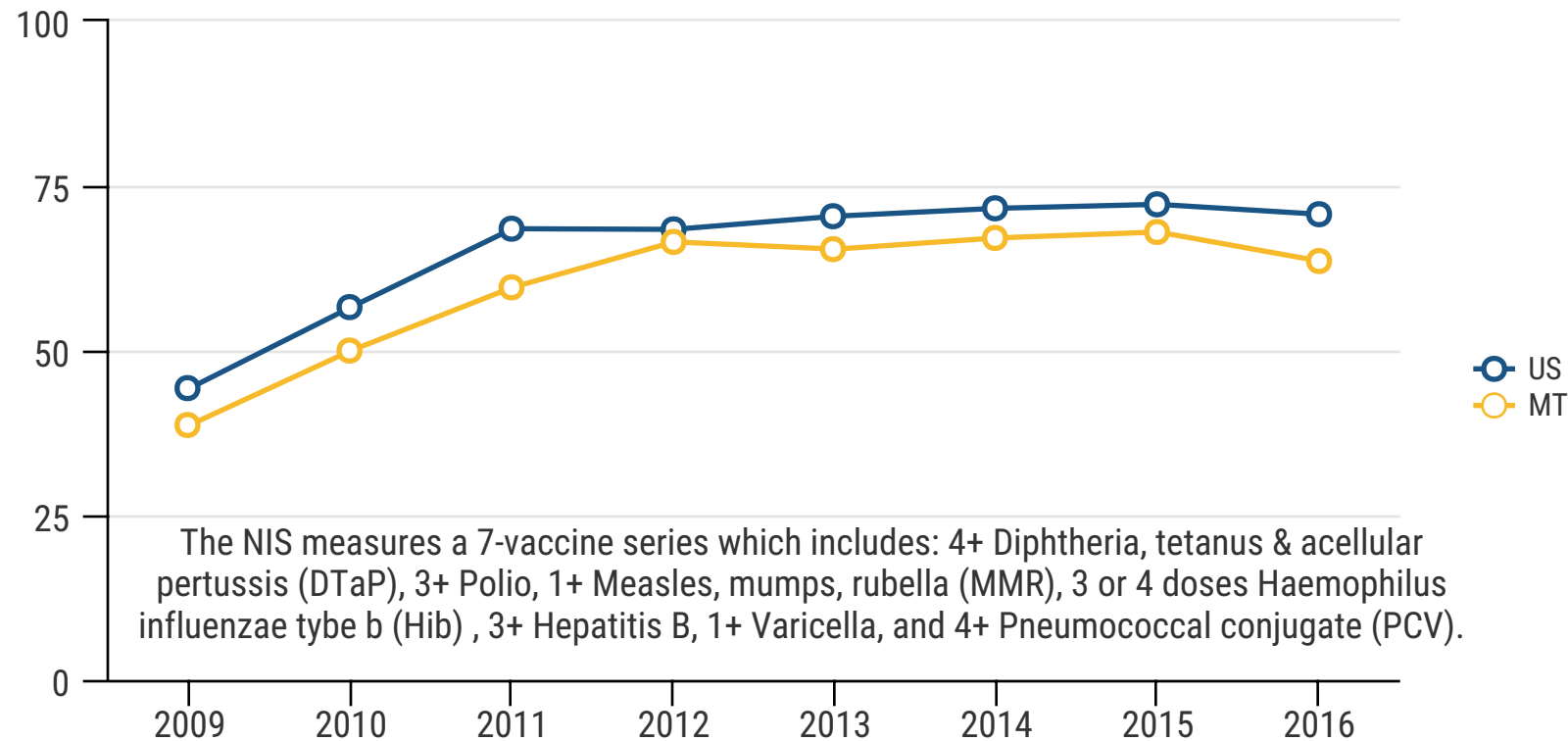
Children age 19-35 months



The National Immunization Survey is a random digit-dialing telephone survey followed by a mailed survey to childrens' immunization providers. This survey collects data on vaccination status of children who are or will be 19-35 months during the survey year.

Actions Montana is Taking to Increase Immunization Rates

- 1 Building new functionality into imMTrax so clinics can review coverage levels real-time.
- 2 Providing monthly missing immunization reports to participating providers.
- 3 Piloting stand-alone clinic assessment visits for targeted providers.
- 4 Proposing a rule change for immunization requirements for licensed child care facilities to more closely align with the ACIP.
