



Injury Deaths in Montana by County (2009-2018)




- Injury* is the leading cause of death for younger Montanans (aged 1-44 years)
- The statewide 2009-2018 age-adjusted injury mortality rate was 84.2 per 100,000 population
- Around 900 Montana residents die each year due to injury
- Nearly two-thirds of injury deaths in the past decade were unintentional
