Background: Widespread novel and seasonal influenza have been noted across Montana. MT DPHHS has activated the MCM Distribution Plan to distribute MCM to Local Health Jurisdictions.

Information: DPHHS Alternate EOC is demobilizing, and PHEP Staff are relocating to the DPHHS Cogswell Building, 1400 Broadway Street, Helena, MT (Capital Campus). The EOC is operating at Level 3 (Elevated). See Attached Emergency Support Function (ESF) 8 Common Operating Picture (COP) and Incident Action Plan (IAP).

Executive Summary: EXERCISE EXERCISE EXERCISE. Widespread novel and seasonal influenza have been noted across Montana and requires resources beyond its ability to respond. MT DPHHS has activated set its operational level to 2-Partial. DPHHS has also implemented the MCM Distribution Plan to distribute needed assets to local health jurisdictions. All required federal and state partner notifications have been made. CDC has notified MT DPHHS of activation of SNS in response to pandemic influenza. MT will receive 250,000 doses (simulated) influenza vaccine from SNS. The DPHHS Commodities Warehouse has been notified and are ready to support distribution operations. This exercise is a full-scale exercise, planned for 4 days duration at the DPHHS Commodities Warehouse at 1400 Carter Drive, Helena.

Last OP Summary: IAP Brief, COP Brief, Command and Staff Meeting, Safety Brief, JITT, Shipped all packages through Mergenthaler, MCM LOG SYNC, COP Slides Updated.

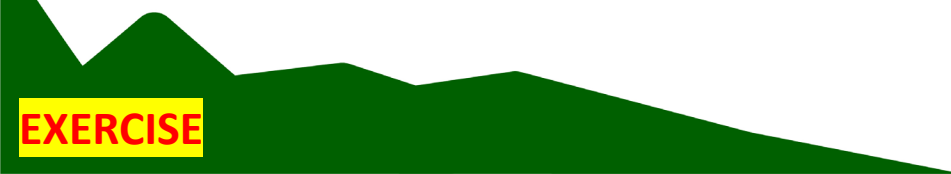

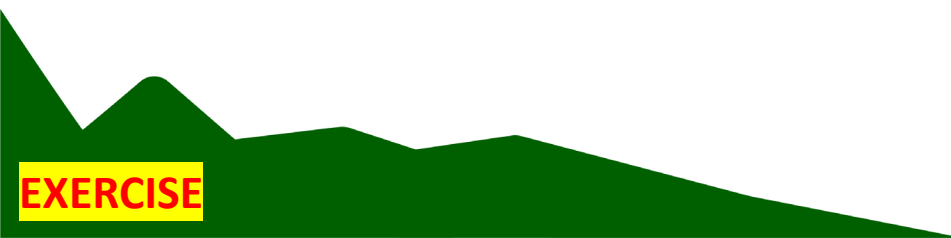

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Incident Update

Assets for distribution with Mergenthalers were picked, labeled, and shipped. Some jurisdictions have received packages through UPS, USPS, and FedEx. Weather continues to be a factor, although the severity has lessened. The trucking company was not able to cover one of the five distribution routes. Two DPHHS employees are assigned to cover the route.

Weather also affected the operability of the communications trailer. This issue severely curtailed communication abilities. To continue the exercise, we switched to the facility's wifi service.

Jurisdictions have begun receiving packages sent via the shipping services.

Weather Forecast

Unseasonably cold temperatures continue through Friday morning. Drier conditions along with a slow warming trend is anticipated through the upcoming weekend. The next chance for precipitation comes late Sunday into Monday, when a disturbance brings scattered showers and mountain snow to the region. Temperatures cool by a few degrees on Monday but slowly warm to near average by next Thursday.

Today

Sunny, with a high near 27. Wind chill values as low as -6. South southwest wind around 6 mph becoming west northwest in the afternoon.

Tonight

Clear, with a low around 8. Wind chill values as low as -4. Light and variable wind becoming south southwest 5 to 8 mph in the evening.

Friday

Sunny, with a high near 37. Wind chill values as low as -1. South wind around 7 mph becoming north in the afternoon.
