Money Follows the Person (MFP) Grant***

Montana's Money Follows the Person (MFP) Grant helps individuals move from institutional settings like nursing homes back into the community. Thank you for considering MFP participants for your rental unit.

An MFP participant must meet several eligibility requirements to receive MFP funding. One of those requirements is to move into a qualified residential setting. For example, it must provide living, sleeping, bathing, and cooking areas over which the participant or their family has control. Also, the unit cannot have more than four unrelated individuals excluding caregivers and personal attendants living there.

An MFP participant is supported by team of case management and direct service providers. The participant receives significant planning time focused on finding appropriate housing and caregivers. The MFP grant may also provide additional support as needed in the following areas:

- Security Deposit
- First month's Rent

The enhanced supports and services offered through the MFP grant are intended to help MFP participants successfully move back into the community and support their ability to remain in the community.
