Legal professionals will assist participants in completing their estate planning documents at no cost. The program serves seniors, age 60 and older, and tribal members. Our services are not designed to handle complex estates or large assets, and we do not handle any trusts.

Durable Power of Attorney for Health Care

Durable Power of Attorney for Financial

Declaration of Living Will

Declaration of Homestead

Simple Will

Indian Will

Professionals will help seniors draft, review, notarize and copy each document. Free resources and educational materials will be available.
