



OUR FACILITIES

The Montana Veterans' Home (MVH) was authorized by the fourth Montana Legislative Assembly in 1895, only six years after the state joined the Union. The first building was dedicated May 30, 1896, and the first resident was admitted June 21, 1897. The initial purpose of the Home was to serve Veterans of the Civil and Indian Wars.

Located along the Flathead River just a few miles from Glacier National Park in the beautiful Flathead Valley, the Home is a 105 bed skilled nursing facility that includes a 15 bed Special Care Unit for those with advanced dementia and Alzheimer's disease. The facility also has a 12 bed domiciliary for those not needing nursing care. Honorably discharged Veterans and their spouses are eligible for admission to MVH.

An individualized care plan is developed for each resident and is monitored by a team of professionals. We take pride in providing quality care.

Our operating funds come from state and federal government.

In March of 1973, local civic leaders formed the Montana Veterans' Home Memorial Foundation. It is an independent board of citizens authorized to receive tax-deductible donations for the direct benefit of our residents. 
