UPDATE: CSCT Intergovernmental Transfer (IGT) Process Transitioning to DPHHS
Effective Date July 1, 2023



With the passage of legislation to transition the Comprehensive School and Community Treatment (CSCT) intergovernmental transfer (IGT) process to DPHHS, the Office of Public Instruction (OPI) and DPHHS are working together on this process. DPHHS and the OPI would like to assure school districts that the transition from the OPI to DPHHS will be seamless and collaborative. Below are some highlights and resources.

<p>IGT Process CSCT will continue to use the same IGT process approved by CMS and effective since October 1, 2021.</p> <p>Timeline The timeline when school districts can access their statements and when payments are due will remain the same. <i>(The timeline for school districts is available online.)</i></p> <p>CSCT Program Program rules and requirements that became effective October 1, 2021, will remain the same. CMHB will continue to oversee the programmatic, enrollment, and claims aspects in addition to the IGT process.</p> <p>AccessGov/Engagement Builder Website DPHHS will continue to utilize the AccessGov/Engagement Builder platform implemented by the OPI. School districts will still be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Download state match statement ○ Download certification form ○ Upload PDF of signed certification form <p>Payment Options School districts will continue to have several payment options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Mail in a paper check ○ Online via electronic check ○ Online via credit/debit card 	<p>New MOU: With the transition of the IGT process to DPHHS, a new signed MOU between DPHHS and the school district will be necessary for claims to be released once the match has been met in full by the due date. The MOU is a CMS requirement.</p> <p>Submission of Non-Federal State Match: DPHHS is not able to accept images of checks still coming via the mail as record of payment.
