SDMI HCBS 345	Meals

Definition

Meals is the provision of hot or cold meals to a member up to twice daily, 7 days a week.

Determination of Need

- (1) The member must demonstrate need for Meals due to:
 - (a) special nutritional needs;
 - (b) the member's inability to gain access to proper nutrition due to disability; or
 - (c) at risk of health decline or institutionalization without consistent nutritious meals.
- (2) Meal services under any other source, including natural supports, are not available.

Provider Requirements

- (1) The provider must follow the rules that govern the provision of nutrition services in Administrative Rules of Montana (ARM) Title 37, Chapter 41, subchapter 3.
- (2) Retirement homes must comply with the licensing requirement in ARM Title 37, Chapter 106, subchapter 25.
- (3) Individual meal providers must be licensed in accordance with the requirements of state law.

Service Requirements

- (1) Meal services may not be furnished to members receiving Residential Habilitation or during the time period they are in an Adult Day Health setting.
- (2) Meal services may not be provided more than two times per day.
- (3) Members who require nutrition services may not receive Meals in excess of the member's medical need.

Utilization

(1) Meals are based on the member's assessed need and are limited to additional services not otherwise covered under Medicaid state plan.
