The Montana Angel Initiative is a voluntary, non-punitive program designed to help individuals with substance use disorder (SUD) – including alcohol use disorder (AUD), and polysubstance use. With the endorsement of Governor Gianforte, this initiative is led by the Department of Public Health and Human Services (DPHHS) and brings together law enforcement agencies, public health organizations, local treatment/recovery resource providers, and community groups across Montana to create a comprehensive network of support for those in need.

Through these trusted collaborations, the MT Angel Initiative offers a clear and compassionate pathway to care – connecting people to treatment professionals, support services, and recovery resources. This initiative is designed to help individuals with SUD, including those who interact with law enforcement in the field or seek help directly at a designated MT Angel Initiative law enforcement or community partner site.
