Dear Chairman Keenan:

Thank you for the Commission's recommendation to provide one-time funding to support start-up costs for Physician Assistant (PA) and Occupational Therapy (OT) Doctorate Programs at the University of Montana College of Health. I share your interest in addressing important workforce shortage gaps and welcome the Commission's insight on this issue.

According to the Department of Labor & Industry (DLI), Montana has a workforce shortage of both OTs and PAs, critical roles in our behavioral health and developmental disability continuum of care. In a 2022 report, DLI estimated that Montana needed to add approximately 67 PAs and 33 OTs to our workforce annually to meet demand. I agree that investing in our state's workforce is vital to ensure we can meet the needs of patients today and in the future.

While I welcome the Commission's recommendation, I want to ensure additional higher education institutions in Montana are eligible to apply for one-time only funding under this initiative. Pursuant to statute, I modify the Commission's recommendation to clarify that any Montana institution of higher education authorized to issue degrees by the Board of Regents per 20-25-107, MCA is eligible to apply for one-time grant funding to support start-up costs associated with launching a PA or OT doctorate program. Accordingly, DPHHS shall establish an application process to evaluate grant proposals of this nature.

Thank you for your thoughtful consideration of the work before you. I am grateful for our continued collaboration as we work to make lasting investments in our state's behavioral health and developmental disabilities systems to better serve Montanans.
