

MCDC Admit Medical Clearance Criteria

Patient Name	Pt. Date of Birth	Today's Date

A patient must be seen and cleared by their Physician, NP, or PA within 5 days of their assigned bed date. The Medical Clearance documentation must be sent to MCDC within 48 hours of that bed date.

Please See Requirements Below:

- Provide **separate** documentation including History and Physical to include:
 - Review of systems including any symptoms such as changes in appetite, chills, fatigue, fever, headache, congestion, cough, sneezing, wheezing, hives, sore throat, rash.
 - Respiratory symptoms such as asthma, breathing problems, chest pain, shortness of breath—at rest or with exertion.
 - Cardiovascular symptoms such as chest pain—at rest or with exertion, dyspnea with exertion.
 - Gastrointestinal symptoms such as diarrhea, nausea, vomiting.
- Vital signs including temperature.
- Current medication list, scheduled and prn medications?
- Is the patient currently symptomatic, or has the patient been symptomatic? Date of onset? Length of illness?
- Has the patient been hospitalized in the past 2 weeks?
- Has the patient traveled to an area of the world with an active COVID-19 outbreak within the last 14 days?
- Has the patient been in proximity with someone who is currently sick with symptoms of COVID-19, or any other respiratory illness within the last 14 days?
- Has the patient ever been diagnosed with COVID-19? **If yes, please provide medical records.**
